Millis Garden Club-  
Plan for Catch Our Drift Site #2 2007

**Location** –strip alongside Rt. 109 and Dover Rd. extension- adjacent to J. William Heights intersection

**Description of site**- planting area measures approximately 15 ft wide and 48 ft in length. It currently contains 1 medium sized oak (topped off due to power line), one small buckthorn and multiple assorted weeds. It has a natural berm shape running parallel to Rt. 109. This berm shape and good visibility from East and West travel make this an ideal site to plant a drift of daffodils.

**Proposed plantings**- 200 daffodils in a mixture of color, size & bloom time- ensuring a mass of color from late April thru May. These daffodils will be scattered throughout the entire bed and be planted in October 2007. The bed will be weeded, planting soil added and will remain unmulched.
